Registration for each session will be accepted only on these dates. The Policy Contract must be signed and submitted at time of registration.

To the Parents/Guardians of Participants in the P.A. After School Program,

To ensure a safe environment, smooth operation and participation in the Parents' Association After School Program, the following guidelines have been put in place.

- Students who have a paraprofessional assigned during the regular school hours may not be assigned a paraprofessional during the afterschool program.
- Students who do not participate in their selected activity may be requested to attend a different activity. Frequent refusal to attend activities may lead to dismissal from the program.
- Students need to demonstrate that they are ready for an extended day.
- Students who exhibit inappropriate behavior during the school day or during the PA After school program will not be permitted to attend the program.
- Students attending the after school program must be signed out from the program, in the main building, unless they are picked up before 2:00 p.m.
- Pick-up time is 5:20 p.m. Students may be picked up earlier and need to be signed out.
- If a student is picked up late, more than three (3) times in one session, he/she will be requested to discontinue attending the program for that session.
- No refunds after enrollment. No exceptions.
- **IMPORTANT** - Three late pickups will result from removal, without reimbursement, from the After School program for that current session.

Please be aware that for the next session and in the future, payments must be made in full at the time of registration.

To ensure the safety of all our children change of days/activities will not be honored.

Registration will be in person, in the main building, **only** during the schedule below:

Monday, February 4th, Wednesday, February 6th and Thursday, February 7th from 3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Please bring completed registration form, signed policy contract, and payment with you at the time of registration. All payments are to be made in full by check or money order payable to: ***P.S. 99 PA After School Program***. Partial payments will not be accepted.

No registrations will be accepted after Thursday, February 7th.

Registration Procedure: You will select activities at the time you register your child. Activities may be limited to a specific number of students attending. Placement will be on a first come, first served basis. If an activity is closed out you will have to select a different activity during that time if need be.

Dismissal: Dismissal begins at 5:20 p.m. All students **MUST** be picked up by 5:30 p.m. If a child is picked up late, more than three (3) times in a session, he/she will be requested to discontinue attending the program for that session.

All students must be picked up by a person listed on the blue emergency card and be at least 18 years of age. NO Exceptions.

IMPORTANT – Activities are contingent upon number of participants and may be cancelled due to low registration. Students will be placed in an alternate activity, if necessary.

****Band****

- Interested 4th, 5th and 6th graders are invited to participate in an after school band on selected wind, brass, and percussion instruments. These weekly classes will take place one day per week during after school extended day program.
- Students will learn how to read beginning music, assemble and play basic notes and rhythms on their instrument, and how to play together as a group. By the end of the year, your child will be able to read music and perform a concert for their families and peers!
- Instruments that will be taught consist of the following instruments only:

flute	trombone
Bb clarinet	euphonium
alto saxophone	glockenspiel bells
trumpet	snare drum
- Parents will be responsible for renting instruments for their children. The rental cost varies, but can average around \$100-\$120 for the entire school year.
- Most rental instruments include basic starter supplies. Additional supplies may need to be purchased later in the school year and these supplies are typically below \$40 annually.
- For students to be successful and reach their potential, we ask that participating musicians take their instruments home and practice 10 minutes, at minimum, five days a week.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES

Band: Students have an opportunity to learn how to play an instrument.

Chess: Students learn and play chess against each other.

Creative Crafts: Students utilize their creative side while making crafts with guidance or on their own.

Exploring Microsoft: Students learn the fundamentals of computers and play various games as well.

Games: Students are allowed to pick through a variety of games and building blocks to explore.

Glee Club: Students work together with the guidance of teachers to put on a performance at middle and end of the year.

Gym: Students are allowed to pick what sports activity they want and have a blast doing it.

Hip Hop Dance: A high-energy class that infuses the latest styles of hip hop where students learn to incorporate their own styles.

Homework Time: Students have the time to complete their homework. If they have questions, they will be assisted, but students are expected to do homework on their own.

Homework Tutorial: Students are expected to do their homework with the supervision of a teacher on that grade or close to it. The homework is then checked as well. If children need help or extra attention, the teachers are there to provide that.

Modern Dance: Students learn modern dance techniques based on various artists to perform, using expressive movements.

Music Through Movement: Students dance along to guided videos of dancing and stretching.

Photography: Students will use iPads to explore the creative side of taking a picture and the elements behind photography. Space is limited to one day per child.

Sketch Art: The teacher bases the complexity of the units according to the enrolled student's capabilities, ranging from the fundamentals of sketching a drawing to three dimensional drawings.

Spanish: Students learn the basics of Spanish.

STEAM Club (formerly Science Club): Students critically think, plan and produce a hands-on project connected to science, technology, engineering, the arts and/or math in order to answer their real world questions about how things work.

Theatre: Students hone in on their acting abilities.

Volleyball: Students learn the basics of volleyball.

Writing: Students have a chance to work on creative writing.

Yoga: Students tap into their inner Zen by learning the basic yoga poses.

NEW - OPEN ACCESS TO LIBRARY – Students in the Afterschool program will have the opportunity to borrow books from the school library on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 2:45-4:00PM. A teacher will be available to sign out books. Students will be allowed to borrow up to two books for a duration of one week.
