¹ Sept. 5 is the first day of school for all students K-12. It is a full day for all students in grades K-12.

² Jan. 21-25, June 2, and June 17-25, 2020 are Regents days for students in grades 9-12.

³ June 26 is the last day of school for all students K-12. Students have an early dismissal (half day). This is also Regents Rating Day. Schools must record daily attendance on this date.

⁴ January 27 is removed from the calendar for high schools and 6-12 schools. All other students must attend school. In contrast, June 11 is removed from the calendar for K-12, K-5, K-6, K-8, 6-8, and D75 programs. All other students must attend school.

⁵ Of the 180 attendance days anticipated for the 2019-20 school year, 168 are considered instructional in high school grades if 12 Regents Days (which are aidable) are subtracted. Changes due to weather or other emergencies may affect these numbers.
